# iPhone stolen by opening parcel with injection

Ahmedabad  
If anyone believes that no one can open the parcel prepared for the purchase made from the online platform, then it is a big mistake. The Ahmedabad Crime Branch has busted a gang that removes the genuine item from the parcel received from the online platform and packs it in fake ones. A gum remover chemical has also been found from them, which they used to fill in the injection and open the parcel. When the police caught the accused, the accused opened the parcel in the presence of the police within two minutes, took out the genuine item and repacked it, which shocked the police.

The Ahmedabad Crime Branch has busted a gang that was systematically running this racket by removing valuable items like iPhones and Apple Watches from parcels and packing them in duplicate. The accused and their friends used to book online orders on fake addresses using various IDs. When the parcel arrived, they would all take out the genuine item from it and replace it with a fake item and give it to an accused named Vishal. A courier

In Surat, the Bakhiya family bid 'Sheru' a final farewell like a human being; The dog breathed its last in the owner's lap

A heartwarming example of a dog lover has been seen in Surat, where the Bakhiya family in Bhatar area gave their beloved dog 'Sheru' a respectful farewell like a human being upon his death. The family's eyes welled up at the loss of Sheru, who breathed his last in his owner's lap, and the sisters tied a final rakhi to him and bid him an emotional farewell.

It is said that the love between animals and humans cannot be expressed in words. This is an incident that has proven that even animals can become an integral part of the family in loyalty and love. The Bakhiya family has set a unique example in the society by cremating their 11-year-old companion 'Sheru' after his death, just like a human.

11 years of unwavering support and loyalty of 'Sheru' 11 years ago today, a 10-day-old German Shepherd breed puppy 'Sheru' came to the Bakhiya family. The family members adopted him not as an animal but as a member of the household. Gradually, Sheru became the darling of the entire family. His popularity was such that the entire society started calling this family not by his name, but as the 'Sheru Wala Ghar'.

After drinking cold water, Sheru breathed his last in the lap of his owner. Yesterday, Sheru completed his 11-year journey. Even in his last

moments, Sheru maintained his love for his owner. After drinking cold water from his owner's hand, Sheru breathed his last peacefully in his lap. This incident had filled the family with grief and tears flowed from the eyes of the members.

One 'brother' of four sisters, sisters tie Rakhi to Sheru every year.

There are four sisters and one brother in the Bakhiya family, but the sisters always considered Sheru as their second brother. Every year, the sisters used to tie Rakhi to Sheru. Even after the daughters left for their in-laws, they did not miss sending a special Rakhi for Sheru along with their own brother. After Sheru's death, the elder daughter, with tearful eyes, tied the last Rakhi to Sheru, who was like her younger brother, and bid a heart-touching farewell.

The family gave a final farewell like a human being. The family members decided that Sheru should be bid farewell not like an ordinary animal, but like a member of the family. Sheru's body was decorated with flowers.

Neighbors and family members gathered together and took out his last rites, chanting the name of God. Just as the rituals are followed in the funeral of a human being, Sheru was emotionally merged into the five elements.

# High Court lawyer along with gang stole cumin seeds worth Rs 3 crore from Unjha

They hatched a great conspiracy and played a trick with a key, the police got a number and the picture was complete

Unknown smugglers stole cumin seeds worth Rs 3 crore from the godown of Khodiyar Estate behind the Descent Hotel near Unawa Highway near Unjha in Mehsana district. The theft took place between December 12, 2025 and January 2, 2026. The smugglers opened the locks of warehouses number 13, 14 and 15 of traders Ritesh Sheth and Arvind Kumar Sheth and cleared thousands of sacks of cumin seeds through trucks in the dark of night, after which a police complaint was registered.

The case of the theft of cumin seeds worth Rs 3.02 crore in Unjha, considered to be the largest gunj market in Asia, is now taking a turn like a film script. The investigation by Mehsana police has revealed that this high-profile theft is not the work of ordinary smugglers but a gang of High Court lawyers, experts in making duplicate keys from Delhi and habitual criminals. The police have arrested five accused involved in this crime and seized a total of Rs 58.15 lakhs in cash, including lakhs.

Delhi's wanted man contacted a High Court lawyer. The theft was planned in a very clever way. Wanted accused Imran Jamil, who lives in Delhi, contacted Ikram Memon, a lawyer from Patan and practicing in the High Court. Imran had accurate information about the quantity of cumin seeds kept in the godown of Khodiyar Estate near Unawat.

Lawyer hires rape accused Sadiq to form a gang at the local level. Lawyer Ikram's job was to prepare a strong gang at the local level to commit theft. For this, he contacted

Sadiq Memon. He was previously involved in the crime of rape and was in contact with the lawyer as he used to come to the High Court for work. In this way, the law expert became the mastermind of this theft.

A Delhi man made duplicate keys, made 8-10 rounds of cumin trucks to steal them. Accused Imran Jamil, who is an expert in making keys, had prepared duplicate keys by looking at the locks of the godown. Accused Gaurav Patel was involved for local help, whose job was to keep the gang alert by keeping an eye on the police or any other movement. From December 12, 2025 to January 2, 2026, the locks were opened with duplicate keys at night, laborers and trucks were brought in and cumin worth crores was cleaned by making 8 to 10 rounds.

Stolen cumin seeds were sold in the markets by posing as farmers. After the theft, accused Wajahat Khan and Shah Nawaz alias Tipu were going to sell this cumin seeds in the market by posing as farmers. They sold cumin seeds worth approximately Rs 1 crore at a price of Rs 3200 in a firm in Deesa. Apart from this, stolen goods were also sold in Unjha and Chansma panthaks and cashed in. A person named Jumma Khan had arranged trucks and laborers in this theft network.

How did the police solve the mystery? Interestingly, even before the complaint of this theft was registered, the Mehsana LCB had received information about a suspicious number that was contacting Unjha to sell cumin at a cheap price. Then, on

January 4, when a complaint was registered with the Unawat police, the police checked the technical surveillance and CCTV footage of the hotel. Jumma Khan's name was revealed during the interrogation of the truck driver seen in the CCTV and the entire gang was exposed by connecting link after link.

The police have recovered Rs 30 lakh from the house of lawyer Ikram Memon, Rs 9.50 lakh from Wajahat Khan, Rs 5 lakh from Sadiq Memon and Rs 50 thousand from Gaurav Patel. In addition, 110 bags of cumin worth Rs 11.50 lakh have also been seized. Currently, the police are investigating by forming separate teams to nab the main accused Imran and Shah Nawaz.

The watchman did not come to guard the godown' Dyp Dinesh Singh Chauhan said that a complaint was registered at the Unawa police station on January 4, 2026 regarding the theft of cumin. Cumin worth more than Rs 3 crore was stolen from two godowns. Both the complainant brothers had filed separate complaints. These brothers have two godowns of cumin in Unawa. A watchman was posted at this godown from December 12, 2015 to January 2, 2026. That watchman was supervising the godown. For a few days, this watchman did not come to guard the godown and kept looking at the lock.

While checking the godown, cumin seeds were missing. Dyp further said that the complainant had sold cumin seeds and the godown needed to be opened. While checking the godown, the cumin seeds that were previously kept were not found.

Mumbai man hosts party for sadhu in Sanand, serves hookah and liquor to doctors-builders-businessmen at weekend home; 81 arrested

In Ahmedabad, Sanand Police raided a high-profile liquor and hookah party at 'Nirvana Greens Weekend Home' near Gorus Seam late last night (February 4) and detained 81 youths. The party was organized in the name of a couple's 25th anniversary, to which a large number of people were invited.

A Mumbai man organized a theme party for AV's 25th wedding anniversary at his private weekend home in Sanand to celebrate his brother-in-law's wedding anniversary. Cake, hookah and alcohol were served on 11 tables and the guests included builders, businessmen and

doctors from Ahmedabad. The police raided and caused a stampede among the party animals, but the police detained 81 people, including 38 girls and 43 boys, and seized a total of Rs 2.91 crore worth of property.

Mumbai's Amit Gopikal Pacheriwal (age 49, resident of Jayant Mahal, D-Road, Marine Drive, opposite Wankhede Stadium, Mumbai) organized a party to celebrate the 25th anniversary of his brother-in-law Adarsh Agarwal. This high-profile party had all kinds of arrangements. From welcome drinks to liquor, hookah and food, arrangements were made. Cake, hookah and liquor were served on 11 tables.

Food counters were set up in the weekend home and cake, hookah and liquor were served on 11 tables. The police raided the party based on a tip-off and chaos ensued. The police detained 81 youths and took them to the government hospital in Sanand for a medical test. Many big personalities and young men and women from the Malletujar family were present. Most of the people arrested by the police are above the age of 35 to 40. The police said that many big personalities and young men and women from the Malletujar family were present at this party.

More than 20 luxury cars have been seized by the police at a party in Sanand. It has been revealed that most of the people caught celebrating the 25th wedding anniversary at the party are builders, businessmen and doctors from Ahmedabad. Medical tests of all the detained youths are underway.

# Fire in Pune's Nidhi Textile Market

Fire brought under control after two hours of struggle A fire broke out in the Nidhi Textile Market in Surat's Pune area early this morning (February 8). The fire started suddenly in the first basement of the market. Due to the wiring and large amount of wooden goods in the basement, the fire quickly took on a ferocious form. The fire was so fierce that its black smoke spread up to the fifth floor, due to which it was as if



the entire market was burning. More than 20 fire engines from five fire stations reached the spot after receiving information about the incident. Officers including the Chief Fire Officer also rushed to the spot. Firefighters brought the fire under control after using water for more than two hours. The

smoke forced the firefighter to go inside wearing oxygen masks. Since it was Sunday, no traders or employees were present here. There is no news of any casualty in the incident at present. It is believed that the fire broke out due to a short circuit. The exact cause of the fire has not been revealed yet.
